Welcome to Waterfowling! This introductory course does not require previous hunting or shooting experience, and you do not need a hunting license for this workshop. Refreshments and lunch will be provided.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Pull on those boots and head into the field for a hands-on introduction to duck hunting! Learn about the tradition, techniques and ethics of hunting waterfowl. WOW's instructors will help you with shotgun patterning and shooting moving clays, setting decoys, duck calling, protocol in blinds, and understanding why a retriever is such an important partner in this hunting experience. Students will be grouped into 4 groups and rotated through 4 stations (schedules provided upon arrival).
